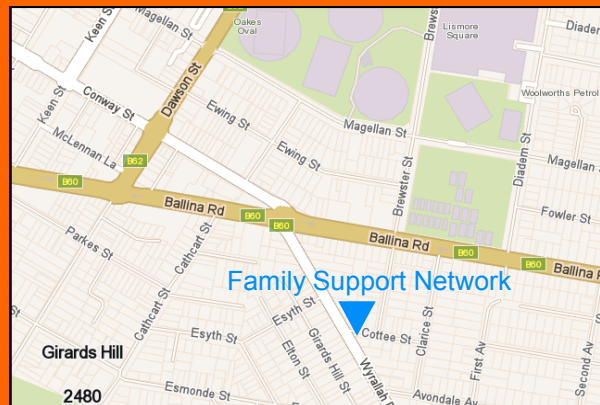

Family workers in the Child Youth & Family Program recognise that parenting can be a tough job. Family workers offer practical and emotional support to assist families through the tough times and to increase their capacity to meet future challenges. Family workers work in partnership with the family to get the support the family need, to strengthen family relationships and to increase the safety and wellbeing of children.



## Who Do We Assist?

Family workers value diversity and welcome people from all cultures and backgrounds. Our services are available to all families in the Lismore area with children 0-17 years of age. We welcome all parents and carers to access our services.

## Why Do Families Come to the Child Youth & Family Program?

Families come to the Program for many reasons and may include:

- Parenting support
- Family relationships
- Family crisis
- Isolation
- Health
- Disability
- Housing

## What do we offer?

- Confidential individual and family sessions with an experienced Family Worker.
- Share ideas and skills about child behavior and child development.
- Assistance with parenting and family routines.
- Skills to improve family communication and reduce stress
- Information, referral and practical assistance to link families with other services, support groups and community resources.
- Parenting Programs and Resources.
- Skill Development Groups.

## Accessing the Service

- Any member of a family can contact us when they are concerned about how their family is managing. Intakes are processed between 10am and 12pm daily.
- Another service or agency could contact us on your behalf.
- Initially you will speak with an Intake Worker who will assess if our service is able to support your family's needs. If not we will link you to a service that can assist.
- If our service is able to assist your family a Family Worker will contact you within 2 weeks to organise an assessment appointment.
- The Family Worker will then work with you and your family to develop goals for how the family would like things to be. The worker will assist your family to achieve those goals.
- The Family Worker can meet with you individually or with your family in your home or at our premises, or other agreed locations.
