## What Do We Provide?

The **Nimbin Family Centre** is aware of the individual needs of children and their parents/carers at different times in their lives. We are a free, open and non-judgmental service, offering:

- A **child friendly** environment with caring staff in a **safe** and **clean** meeting place. Morning tea is provided.

- **Weekly playgroups:**

**Start Together Babies Group** for parents & carers with babies up to 12 months of age. During school term, **Wednesday 9.30 to 11.30 am.**

These sessions focus on early childhood development & literacy.

**Wednesday afternoon Playgroup**

1pm—3pm during school term.

For parents & carers with their children up to school age.

- **Guest speakers** from a variety of different services with lots of interesting information on kids and families as directed by participants.
- **Professional family support** and helpful information on parenting.
- Group programs promoting **pleasurable parenting**, contact us for dates / times.

- Referral and **Advocacy.**
- **Links** to other services such as childcare, housing, legal service, family and child services and Start Together Program.
